



New Mobile Market collaborations bring free fresh food to patients in Suffolk County

Mass General Brigham is collaborating with La Colaborativa and the YMCA of Greater Boston on mobile markets that will bring free, fresh produce and shelf-stable items to individuals experiencing high rates of food insecurity.

The markets operate as mobile grocery stores, visiting multiple sites weekly, including Mass General Brigham health centers, senior housing and community hubs. A nutritionist will be on site to provide nutrition education and resources, and each session serves approximately 150–160 people.
