- Training classes are online, self-paced with hands-on lab sessions scheduled in the Greater Boston Area. Enjoy the flexibility of no set schedule, ideal for working adults
- Up to 6 months to complete coursework
- Upon training completion, participants receive career services support, including resume review and help applying for roles at MGB
- Participants earn a certificate of completion from University of Massachusetts Global
- After 30 days of employment, participants can sit for the national certification exam

Tuition-Free Training: This program is funded by the Good Jobs Challenge grant and is available at no cost to residents of the following counties: Bristol, Essex, Middlesex, Norfolk, Plymouth, Suffolk, and Worcester. Starting salary is \$18.50/hour.
