What are the Infection Prevention Standards for individuals from a Suppliers/Business (“Supplier Employees”) at Mass General Brigham?

The infection prevention requirements include 1) seasonal influenza for anyone working onsite at a Mass General Brigham facility or patient home for one day or more and 2) a series of additional health requirements detailed here: <https://massgeneralbrigham.org/Vendors/InfectionPrevention> for anyone working onsite at a Mass General Brigham hospital, healthcare facility, or patient home for more than 3 weeks (cumulative 120 hours over the course of one year).

Are medical or religious exemptions permitted?

Exemptions are not permitted for Supplier Employees. Suppliers are requested to only send individuals to Mass General Brigham properties or patient homes that meet the applicable Infection Prevention Standards.

Who is responsible for verifying Supplier/Business compliance with the Mass General Brigham Infection Prevention Standards?

Suppliers are required to monitor compliance of their employees with Mass General Brigham policies and be prepared to provide clinical documentation of Infection Prevention requirements upon request. If documentation is requested and cannot be provided, the Supplier Employee will not be allowed access to Mass General Brigham facilities.

For Suppliers that participate in Green Security vendor credentialing system, documentation will need to be uploaded into the system prior to arriving on site to any Mass General Brigham facility.
