

What are the Infection Prevention Standards for individuals from suppliers/vendors (“Business Employees”) at Mass General Brigham?

The infection prevention requirements include 1) vaccinations for COVID-19, including the booster as recommended by the CDC, and seasonal influenza for anyone working onsite at a Mass General Brigham facility for one day or more and 2) a series of additional health requirements detailed here (<https://www.massgeneralbrigham.org/supplier-vendor-information>) for anyone working onsite at a Mass General Brigham hospital or healthcare facility for more than 3 weeks (cumulative 120 hours over the course of one year).

Are boosters required for Business Employees to be considered fully vaccinated for COVID-19?

Yes, Mass General Brigham requires all business employees to have the CDC recommended booster by June 30, 2022 to be permitted to work in a MGB facility.

Are medical or religious exemptions permitted?

Exemptions are not permitted for Business Employees. Businesses are requested to only send individuals to Mass General Brigham properties that meet the applicable Infection Prevention Standards.

Who is responsible for verifying supplier/vendor compliance with the Mass General Brigham Infection Prevention Standards?

Businesses are required to monitor compliance of their employees with Mass General Brigham policies and be prepared to provide clinical documentation of Infection Prevention requirements upon request. If documentation is requested and cannot be provided, the Business Employee will not be allowed access to Mass General Brigham facilities.

In addition, all Business Employees visiting a MG Brigham facility are expected to complete a Mass General Brigham Pre-screen Pass (<https://prescreen.massgeneralbrigham.org>) before arriving at the facility. As part of the pre-screen, Business Employees will be asked to attest to being fully vaccinated for COVID-19 and Influenza and to confirm that they are not experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms. The prescreen should be completed each day the Business Employee will be entering a Mass General Brigham facility.

For Businesses that participate in Green Security vendor credentialing system, documentation will need to be uploaded into the system prior to arriving on site to any Mass General Brigham facility. The daily attestation is completed via the Green Security portal and therefore participating business employees do not need to complete the Mass General Brigham pre-screen.
